- Cowboy Roundup USA will furnish meat tenderized and portioned; potatoes; dried pinto beans; milk; flour; shortening; sugar; butter; bottled water; fruit for cobbler; ice; judging containers; drinks; plates and plastic ware.
- Each wagon will cook Pan Fried Steak, mashed potatoes, pinto beans, sourdough biscuits, cobbler and white gravy. Gravy will not be turned in for judging.
- ALL BISCUITS MUST BE SOURDOUGH.
- WAGON AND CAMP JUDGING WILL BEGIN FRIDAY AT 12:00 NOON.
- Each wagon will hand crank one freezer of ice cream Friday to be judged and to be served to the public from 7:00 to 9:00 pm. Please bring your own ingredients except milk.
- All food must be cooked on site on wood fires; do not bring pre-mixes.
- Below ground fire pits are **NOT** allowed. **WE WILL FURNISH TRACTOR WHEEL RIMS FOR YOUR USE OR, YOU MAY BRING YOUR OWN ABOVE GROUND FIRE PIT.**
- Bring your own cooking wood.
- Maximum crew size allowed is **SIX**, including the head cook.
- Cooking crews should wear clothing of the period.
- Dutch oven liners may be used.
- Advertising on the wagons will not be allowed.
- Any motorized vehicle inside the Chuck Wagon fence after Friday at noon or anytime Saturday will result in disqualification.
- Wagon crews will be welcomed at the COORS WAGON FOR A PRIME RIB DINNER SERVED BY THE FAMED COORS COWBOY CLUB ON THURSDAY FROM 7:00 TO 9:00PM.
- Distribution of non-perishable food items Friday between 1:00 and 3:00 pm.
- Distribute perishable food items Saturday 6:30 am.
- Each wagon should deliver judging food to the judging station at 11:45 am Saturday.
- Dinner bell for the public at 12:00 noon Saturday. Do not serve the public until 12:00 noon.
- Each wagon should serve the public; please do not let them serve themselves. Please serve until all food is gone or until 2:00 pm.
- Awards Ceremony will be Saturday approximately 5:00 pm at the campsite.
- Cash awards will be presented and the Champion will receive the World Championship Buckle.
